Call to Worship[†]

Call to Confession

God calls us to regularly confess our sins to Him in prayer, but especially together in worship. The Lord promises that if we come before Him in faith and humility, He will keep His promise to "forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness" for the sake of Jesus Christ.

1 John 1:5-10

This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practise the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

Confession of Sins[†]

We confess our sins individually but also together, as the corporate body of Christ.

Prayer of Confession:

Almighty and most merciful Father, we have erred and strayed from your ways like lost sheep.

We have followed too much the devices and desires of our own hearts.

We have offended against your holy laws.

We have left undone those things which we ought to have done, and we have done those things which we ought not to have done;

and there is no health in us.

O Lord, have mercy upon us, miserable offenders.

Spare all those who confess their faults.

Restore all those who are penitent, according to your promises declared to all people in Christ Jesus our Lord.

And grant, O most merciful Father, for his sake, that we may now live a godly, righteous, and sober life, to the glory of your holy Name. Amen.

Assurance of Forgiveness & Pardon

Through the life, death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, God forgives us all our sins. God's promises are publicly read out, so that every sinner may know that if they have confessed their sins, they are truly washed away.

Sunday School - Heidelberg Catechism

The Heidelberg Catechism (1563) is a warm, beloved confession of Christian faith in 129 questions and answers. These are categorized into fifty-two "Lord's Days" for weekly teaching. It outlines Reformed doctrine and the believer's journey from sin to salvation to deliverance.

LORD'S DAY 26

Q. 69: How is it signified and sealed unto you in holy baptism that you have part in the one sacrifice of Christ on the cross?

A. Thus, that Christ has appointed this outward washing with water and added the promise that I am washed with His blood and Spirit from the pollution of my soul, that is, from all my sins, as certainly as I am washed outwardly with water, by which the filthiness of the body is commonly washed away.

Q. 70: What is it to be washed with the blood and Spirit of Christ?

A. It is to have the forgiveness of sins from God through grace, for the sake of Christ's blood, which He shed for us in His sacrifice on the cross; and also to be renewed by the Holy Spirit, and sanctified to be members of Christ, that we may more and more die unto sin and lead holy and unblamable lives.

Q. 71: Where has Christ assured us that we are washed with His blood and Spirit as certainly as we are washed with the water of baptism?

A. In the institution of baptism, which reads thus: Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptising them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit (Matt. 28:19). And: He that believeth and is baptised shall be saved; but he that disbelieveth shall be condemned (Mark 16:16). This promise is also repeated where the Scripture calls baptism the washing of regeneration and the washing away of sins (Titus 3:5; Acts 22:16).
